Grant Overview

Title I, Part A supports local educational agencies and schools serving high numbers or high percentages of students from low-income families. Districts commonly use Title I to strengthen academic achievement, expand targeted supports, improve family engagement, and build schoolwide or targeted assistance strategies for students who need additional help.

Alignment at a Glance

Panorama helps schools and districts strengthen MTSS and intervention management, support differentiated student support, deepen family engagement, and drive data-informed school improvement in high-poverty settings.



Student Success

- Unifies academics, attendance, behavior, graduation, and life skills data in one place so staff can identify students who need support quickly
- Supports intervention planning, progress monitoring, referrals, collaboration, and strategic reporting for schoolwide and targeted assistance efforts
- Helps leaders monitor chronic absenteeism, behavior, coursework, and intervention efficacy to guide Title I decision-making



Surveys & Engagement

- Helps districts gather valid feedback from students, families, and staff on belonging, engagement, school climate, safety, and family-school relationships
- Supports family engagement planning and school improvement by giving leaders actionable survey data across schools and student groups



Solara

- Helps educators draft intervention plans, family letters, attendance plans, and student support resources using district materials and student context
- Can accelerate staff capacity in high-need schools by reducing time spent on manual documentation and routine support tasks



Solara with Class Companion

- Supports differentiated assignments, rubric-aligned feedback, and personalized scaffolds that help students revise, persist, and improve
- Useful when Title I funds are supporting supplemental academic help, stronger writing supports, or differentiated classroom instruction



Panorama Pathways

- Can support secondary dropout prevention and on-track monitoring by flagging students who are off-track for graduation or missing key milestones
