Grant Overview

Title V, Part B authorizes the Rural Education Achievement Program (REAP), designed to help rural districts that may lack the personnel and resources to compete effectively for competitive grants and that often receive formula allocations too small to meet intended purposes on their own. Districts often use REAP for flexible, high-leverage investments that improve outcomes and staff efficiency.
