Here are three key insights about Delmar

Occasional Lower Grades in ELA

This student generally earns high grades in ELA with A's in Q1 and B+'s in Q2. However, the Q3 grade dropped to a B. While still a good grade, this shows some decline. With strong grades in most quarters, the student has potential to improve.

Room for Growth in Grit and Emotion Regulation

On self-assessments of social-emotional skills, this student rated lower in Grit (3.3-4.3) and Emotion Regulation (2.7-4.1) compared to other skills. However, Grit improved from 3.3 to 4.3 and Emotion Regulation improved from 2.7 to 4.1 from the October to March surveys. The student is showing positive growth in these areas.

High Absences in Some Courses

This student has relatively high absences in some courses like General Art 7 (3), Social Studies 7 (3), and Homeroom (6). However, they have 0-2 absences in other courses. Identifying reasons for isolated absences could help improve attendance.

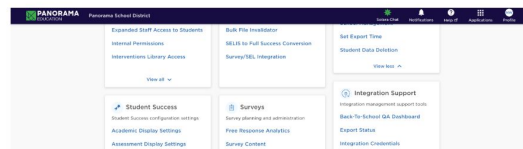
